

## What is an Emergency Escape Breathing Apparatus?

- 15-year service life
- 15-minute breathing capacity
- 2.1lbs
- Loose fitting cover for head and neck
- No requirement for clean shaven policy
- Pre-trip inspections are required
- Simple 4-point inspection
- Must be stored in a climate-controlled environment
- Single use device





## FRA EEBA Rule Requirements


- Applicable to all CN employees who are in the cab of a locomotive of an in-service freight train transporting a PIH material and/or residue of a PIH material.
- To be carried with employees in their grips while operating PIH trains, to be kept inside the cab of the locomotive.
- Considered safety equipment and decertifiable if tampered with.
- Pre-trip inspections required by FRA.
- Inspections must be kept for a minimum of 92 days.
- Periodic inspection records are required to be kept for up to 1 year.



Compliance required by March 26, 2025

#### **CN Documentation & Enablon**

- Operating Rules roll out February 1<sup>st</sup>always have an EEBA with you
- EEBA Pre-Trip Inspection performed on Enablon
  - Required prior to boarding <u>any train.</u>
    - Transportation personnel can bid on trains with PIH at any point, deadhead on trains with PIH or residues, or may be rescheduled last minute on trains with PIH.
    - It is critical to always have an EEBA with you when boarding locomotives.
  - <u>EEBA@cn.ca</u> for any troubleshooting issues.
- EEBA Asset Tracking and Management performed on Enablon
  - Transportation Management are attributed the role of "Device Manager"
  - <u>EEBA@cn.ca</u> for any troubleshooting issues.



Enablon will be the one stop shop for EEBA inspections and asset tracking & management.



# **Training**

- Training has been available as of February 1<sup>st</sup> for end users.
- Training is required prior to employees being issued an EEBA.
- Training has been pushed to all transportation employees and managers in my360.
- Training is 25minutes in length and required for all users.

# **Distribution Specifics**



- 3660 units to be distributed one time
  - Batches will be sent to 31 major locations.
- Major base in Homewood, IL
  - To ensure sufficient inventory at all times, a base stock will be kept in Homewood and periodic inventory replacement will be sent out as requested (email <u>EEBA@cn.ca</u> for stock replenishment)
- New hires will receive their units at Homewood Campus
  - New hire and refresher training will incorporate a hands-on training component with a trainer model of the EEBA.
- CN support will be provided for day shift distribution of EEBAs between Feb 1 and March 16th 2025 (some specific locations will have night shift support).
- Supporting persons for this roll out are the industrial hygienist, dangerous goods officers and environmental officers
